Timetable, background information and arrangements for admission to Ranelagh School : September 2021

The admission arrangements for admission to Ranelagh School from September 2021 were subject to consultation in 2015 in accordance with the School Admission Code 2014.

Timetable

Publication of Ranelagh School admission arrangements for September 2021 on the Ranelagh School website: 28th February 2020.

Publication by Bracknell Forest Council of a Composite Prospectus for entry to Year 7 for Ranelagh and other Bracknell Forest Secondary Schools: 12th September 2020 (on the Bracknell Forest Council website and also available in hard copy; many local primary schools may distribute copies).

Information evening for prospective Year 7 parents:

A virtual presentation will be available during the week beginning Monday 21st September.

The Ranelagh Prospectus will also be available on the school website.

National closing date for secondary school applications: 31st October 2020.

National offer day for secondary school places: 1st March 2021.

Appeals should be made by 30th March 2021 - to guarantee being considered in the main appeal hearings [7th – 9th June 2021].

In-Year Applications

Application may be made at any time after the start of the year for admission to Ranelagh.

Ranelagh complies with Bracknell Forest's timeline for admissions and therefore an application for the next academic year can be made no earlier than the date set out in Bracknell Forest's Guide to In-Year Applications.

Sixth Form Applications

The closing date for sixth form applications is **20th November 2020**.

Published Admission Number (PAN)

The Governors have determined that the Year 7 PAN for September 2021 shall be 165 students.

The Governors have determined that the Year 12 PAN for external applicants in September 2021 shall be 15 students.

Analysis of admissions 2020

Ranelagh is a very popular school and has been oversubscribed for a number of years.

For entry in September 2020 for Year 7 initially 165 places were available. The initial allocation of places was as follows: three places to children with an Educational Health Care Plan [SEN] and six places to Looked After Children [LAC] were awarded a statutory place leaving a further 156 places to be allocated by the Governing Body.

In March, the Governing Body at Ranelagh agreed to admit 9 students above PAN for Year 7 entry in September 2020.

Analysis of admissions 2019

Ranelagh is a very popular school and has been oversubscribed for a number of years.

In November 2018, the Governing Body at Ranelagh agreed to admit 9 students above PAN [165] for Year 7 entry in September 2019. The initial allocation of places was as follows: 5 places to children with an Educational Health Care Plan [SEN], and 11 Looked After Children [LAC] were awarded a statutory place leaving a further 158 places to be allocated by the Governing Body.

Analysis of admissions 2018

Ranelagh is a very popular school and has been oversubscribed for a number of years.

For entry in September 2018 for Year 7 initially 165 places were available. The initial allocation of places was as follows: 12 places to Looked After Children [LAC] and 4 children with Educational Health Care Plan [SEN], were awarded a statutory place leaving a further 149 places to be allocated by the Governing Body.

In May, the Governing Body at Ranelagh agreed to admit 9 students above PAN for Year 7 entry in September 2018.
