



## **Impact of COVID-19 on teaching and learning for students currently in Year 13 at Ranelagh School**

During the lockdown period from March-July 2020, students at Ranelagh followed their usual timetable, with teaching and learning resources being provided for each lesson via Microsoft *Teams*. Whilst this provision included some "live" lessons in most subjects, learning was obviously disrupted by the partial closure of schools, with significantly fewer opportunities for students to interact with their teachers than usual. Students missed out on chances to consolidate their learning through the discussion, Q&A and interaction with their peers that are usually an important aspect of their lessons at school.

Students' predicted grades have been informed by the work that they have completed throughout their courses so far, including assignments undertaken during lockdown. Formal assessments took place online at the end of the academic year, with these grades informing decisions about predicted grades, along with all of the other work that students have completed.
