



Fundraising Focus for 2020-2021

1 IT Infrastructure

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the school is working hard to adapt to different ways of supporting teaching and learning and would like to upgrade the IT infrastructure to better support blended or hybrid learning opportunities for students. The PTA has pledged to contribute **£3,500** towards IT infrastructure in classrooms and upgrades to support blended learning this academic year.

2 Counselling

Every year the PTA contributes to the school's pastoral care provision by contributing to the annual fees for Youthline and other counselling provision. We would like to continue to support the school by pledging to give **£1,500** towards this year's counselling provision.

3 Outside shelter

The school would like to erect a number of outside shelters to enable students to take shelter in bad weather or in the hotter summer months. This is especially important with the current social distancing rules in place, giving the school more options to manage student flow around the school in a safe way. 4 Curriculum projects


We would like to raise **£2,000** to be put into a 'pot' to be allocated to curriculum areas following a bid process. We will share details with you when we have further details about the successful bids.
